


Dear 8th Grade Student & Parents,

<b>COURSE SCHEDULING NIGHT</b> 	<b>FEBRUARY 21</b>	In early February, Acceptance, Conditional Acceptance, Wait List, or Denial Letters will be mailed home. If accepted, you will have the option to schedule classes online or come to the school for an in-person scheduling. If selecting in-person scheduling, it will be held on February 21. The week before February 21, look for an email with more information.
<b>PLACEMENT EXAMS</b> 	<b>MAY 6 &amp; 13</b>	Together with the Junior High teacher recommendations and standardized test scores, these exams will be used to determine the rigor of class in which a student will be enrolled. These exams will be in the areas of Mathematics, English, and Foreign Language when applicable. Placement in other courses such as Biology, will be determined by the student's English score.

GATHER



**Birth Certificate** (copy of state-issued form)

**Current grades** (be sure to include ALL subjects; a phone's screenshot of PowerSchool usually does not capture all subjects)

**\$125 non-refundable application fee** per student (\$150 after January 15, if seats remain available in the Class of 2027). Payment will be online at the end of the application

**Choice of FACTS tuition payment plan.** *The application will not be considered final until this is completed. You will actually complete the application, receive an email and use the link in the email to select a plan.*

If applicable:

**Custody papers**

**Student's IEP/ISP, 504/CAP, CSEP, ILP** or other service plan including the Special Education Application (for ISP/IEP students) found on our website at BishopDwenger.com under the menu, select "Admissions" and scroll to the application.
