Current grades (be sure to include ALL subjects; a phone's screenshot of PowerSchool usually does not capture all subjects). A current report card is acceptable.

Application Deadline is January 15. Any applications submitted after this date could be subject to a wait list. The registration fee has been waived through February 1.

\$150 non-refundable registration fee per student application starting February 2. Payment will be online at the end of the application. This fee is applied to tuition.

Choice of FACTS tuition payment plan. The application will not be considered final until this is completed. You will actually complete the application, receive an email and use the link in the email to select a plan.


Dear 8th Grade Student & Parents,

PLACEMENT EXAMS



MAY 4 & 11

Together with the Junior High teacher recommendations and standardized test scores, these exams will be used to determine the rigor of class in which a student will be enrolled.

These exams will be in the areas of Mathematics, English, and Foreign Language when applicable. Placement in other courses such as Biology, will be determined by the student's English score.
